EXPENSES:

There are several FEES and purchases that must be made during your student’s high school career, such as:

- Admission fees to plays required for class (such as TPAC) Lock rental fee (\$2) for gym locker
- Club fees (such as Model UN & Youth Legislature)

Textbooks are provided and are to be returned in good and usable condition. If the books are lost or stolen, they must be replaced before the student will receive his grades for the year.

Expenses for seniors: Cap and gown, Invitations (based on individual order) and senior graduation fee (usually around \$25). In addition, there are several “extras” that are not necessary but nice. Yearbooks cost approximately \$65-\$85 each year, class pictures each year, special picture package for seniors, senior video and graduation announcements, class ring, student athletic booster club discounted membership, AP exams, PROM, and T-shirts for various activities.
